**Microwave Dumpling**  
(Microwave 800 Watts)

**Ingredients**

(Cup size =8 fluid ounces)

- 1/4lb block margarine
- 1 cup dark brown sugar
- 1 dessert spoon Black treacle
- 1 dessert spoon Golden syrup
- 6oz sultanas
- 6oz raisins
- 1/2 tspn baking soda
- 3/4 cup Murphys Stout or Guinness
- 2 eggs, beaten (standard)
- 2 tspns cinnamon or mixed spice or 1 of each
- 1 cup SR flour or wholemeal add more flour if mixture wet

**Method:**

- Line 2 pint pudding basin with cling film, bringing well over edge
- Pour in mixture and cover with piece of kitchen towel
- Cook full power for 8mins. If centre still wet cook for another 1 -2 mins.
- Put large plate over basin, tip upside down. Carefully remove cling film and you will see skin forming
- Leave to cool
