and **three subject categories**; Land / People / 'Other' (this may include wildlife, infrastructure or anything else which does not fit in to the categories of 'land or 'people')

(you may submit to more than one subject category, but no more than one photograph per entrant per category)

- be broadly landscape in shape, i.e. wider than they are high (though we reserve the right to crop them to suit the exact dimensions of the final calendar design)
- be 300 dpi or above to enable printing at a high resolution
