Additional information to the agenda for the meeting being held on Wednesday 7th January 2015 at 7pm at Graig Community Centre, Bassaleg (**Item No 4 on the agenda**)

- 1. Play Areas** – NCC have an online survey which can be completed to allow residents to have an input into the development of the proposed play areas. It is available to fill in until Sunday 11th January and the site address for the questionnaire is: <https://www.surveymonkey.com/s/T2FTQ2Z>
- 2. Adoption of Footpath Opposite Garth Terrace & Highfield Lane** – Cllr Cornelious is still working on this issue. The footpath at the top of Highfield Lane opposite the green and down to the gate has been cleared because of health and safety concerns by the Community Council. This is a temporary measure until the issue of responsibility can be resolved.
- 3. Lighting on footbridge over A467** - It has been confirmed that the trees have been cut back and the street lighting is in working order so this item will be removed from future reports..
- 4. Dedicated Right Turn Into Laurel Drive** - It is believed that the feasibility survey has been carried out. This will be checked and progress logged in future reports. This item will remain on this report until the Council has confirmation that work is to begin.
- 5. Raised Path on Caerphilly Road** - The banking has been cut back, the path will be checked and if cleared this item will be removed from future reports.
