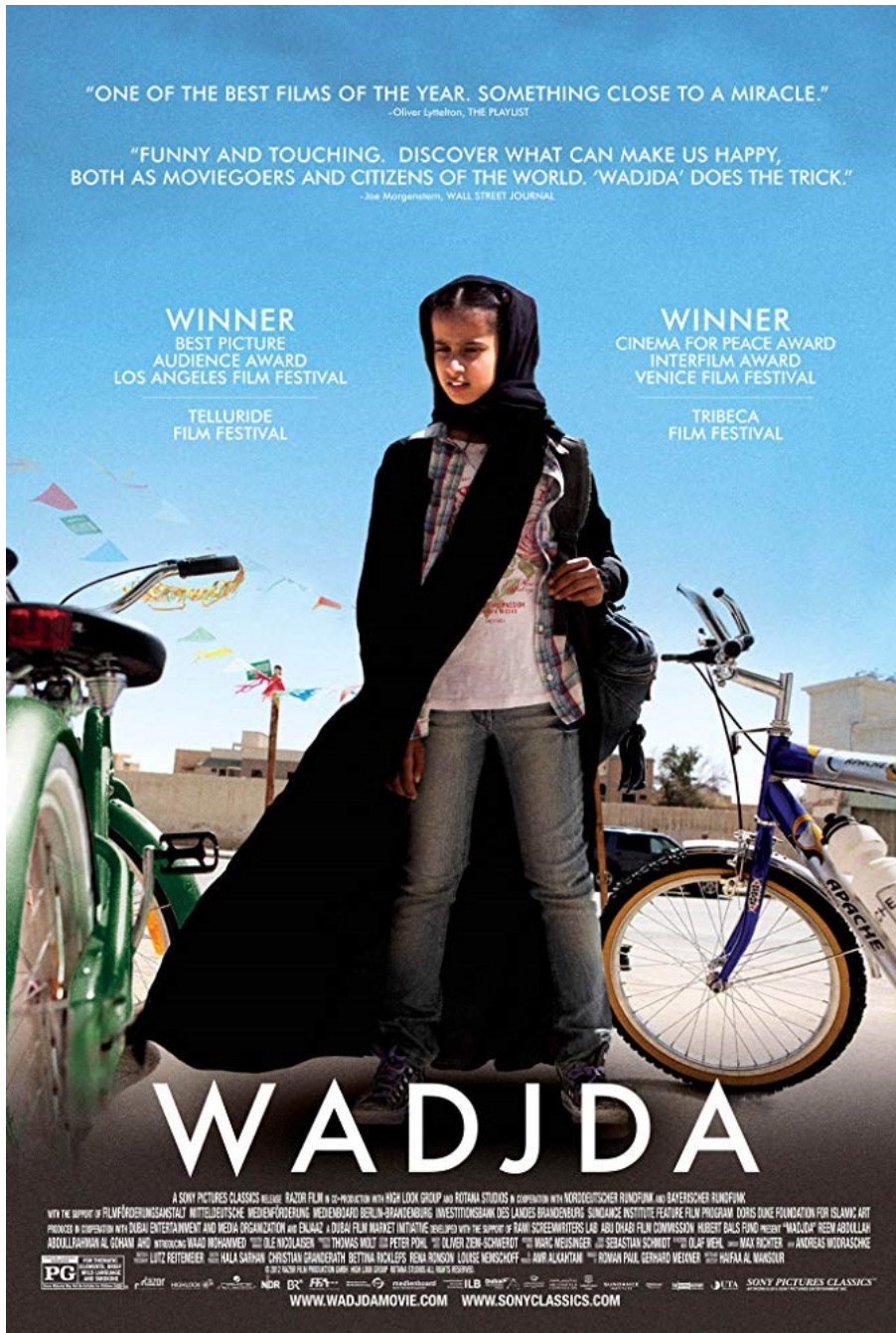

# Wadjda (2012)

WADJDA is a 10-year-old girl living in a suburb of Riyadh, the capital of Saudi Arabia. Although she lives in a conservative world, Wadjda is always pushing the boundaries of what she can get away with. After a fight with her friend Abdullah, a neighbourhood boy she shouldn't be playing with, Wadjda sees a beautiful green bicycle for sale. She wants the bicycle desperately so that she can beat Abdullah in a race. But Wadjda's mother won't allow it, fearing repercussions from a society that sees bicycles as dangerous to a girl's virtue. So Wadjda decides to try and raise the money herself.

This is a film of firsts—the first film to be filmed entirely in Saudi Arabia, and the first feature length Saudi film with a female director.

In a country where until recently cinemas were banned and women could not drive, writer- director **Haifaa Al Mansour** has broken many barriers with her new film.
