

Clerk's report/notes – Parish Council meeting – 18 April 2018

- 1 Steve Jones – out of parish
- 3 Minutes for 21 March 2018 – previously distributed
- 4.1 Brought forward from last month
- 4.2 See also item 6.3
- 4.3 Further to resident's comments at last meeting
- 4.4 As an individual, later identified as a councillor, Cllr Rolfe attended the display/consultation on the airfield at which Countryside Properties stated that, if the Parish Council spoke with them they would be prepared to look at traffic calming, etc along Broadway, presumably as part of S106 agreement
- 4.5 (4.2 Oct 2017) It was resolved to pay the £50.00 contribution requested by CCC but it was not followed up/actioned
(4.2 White lines in Hall Close – to consider CCC response and request for £50 contribution towards the costs RESOLVED that the Parish Council is willing to pay the sum of £50.00 towards having the lines reinstated. (Prop NB, 2nd TW, unanimous)
- 4.6 The date chosen for the APM will not be possible as there is a regular class in the Cherry Tree Room on 2nd Wednesdays each month. Tuesday 8th or Thursday 10th is possible.
- 4.7 I am awaiting a response from Liam Flatters, SCDC surveyor, regarding this problem. He has previously recommended that SCDC should check the ditch at regular intervals over each Winter period.
- 4.8 Cllr Rolfe spoke with Jenna Oakes, Monday 9 April, who stated that, having suggested April for the work, heard nothing more. I asked for the earliest date to complete the work on the dead elm and the horse chestnut branch. She has now come back thinking they might be within the TPO area (verify that anything *Bourn Hall* side of the boundary is, the allotments site is NOT) but the earliest the work can be done is 23 July 2018.
- 4.9 Only one estimate to hand
- 4.10 and 4.11 Suggest postpone to end of meeting, should any non-councillors be present.
- 6.3 Following recommendations from John Vickery (Parish Clerk, Cambourne) about a .gov.uk domain Cllr Rolfe contacted the web designers who put together both Cambourne and Papworth Everard parish websites, amongst others. - 6.4 Possibly ordered in error following a very long wait for the bin previously ordered through SCDC which has since been sited by the bench at Alms Hill. A request has been received to use this one to replace damaged bin at the far end of Jubilee Playing Field by the footpath to Caxton End.
