

**PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER
HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 - SECTION 119**

**The Cambridgeshire County Council (Public Footpaths Nos.3 and 4
(part), Bourn) Public Path Diversion Order 2012**

This Order is made by Cambridgeshire County Council ("the authority") under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the authority that in the interests of the owner of the land crossed by the footpaths described in paragraph 1 of this Order it is expedient that the line of the paths should be diverted.

The South Cambridgeshire District Council have been consulted as required by section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

BY THIS ORDER:-

- 1.** The public rights of way over the land situate at Bourn and shown by bold continuous lines on the map contained in this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be stopped up on the date that the new routes have been certified as provided below.
- 2.** There shall at the end of 1 day from the date of confirmation of this Order be public footpaths over the land situate at Bourn described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by bold broken lines on the map contained in this Order.
- 3.** The stopping up of the footpaths described in Part 1 of the Schedule shall not come into force until Cambridgeshire County Council has certified that the works required to bring the new site of the footpaths described in Part 2 of the schedule into a fit condition for use by the public have been completed.

PART 1 DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING PATH OR WAY

A-B on Order map	Part of Public Footpath No.3, Bourn starting near Brooklands House, at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference TL3156 5725 (point A) and proceeding as a grass path in a north-north-westerly and westerly direction for approximately 74 metres onto a track at Grid Reference TL3149 5727 (point B)	Length approximately 74m
A-C-D-E on Order map	Part of Public Footpath No.4, Bourn starting near Brooklands House at Grid Reference TL3156 5725 (point A) and continuing as a grass path in a westerly direction for approximately 11m to a bridge over Bourn Brook at Grid Reference TL3155 5725 (point C) and then proceeding in a westerly direction for approximately 61m to a stile at Grid Reference TL3149 5725 (point D) and continuing westerly to a farm track at Grid Reference TL3149 5725 (point E)	Length approximately 73m

PART 2 DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF NEW PATH OR WAY

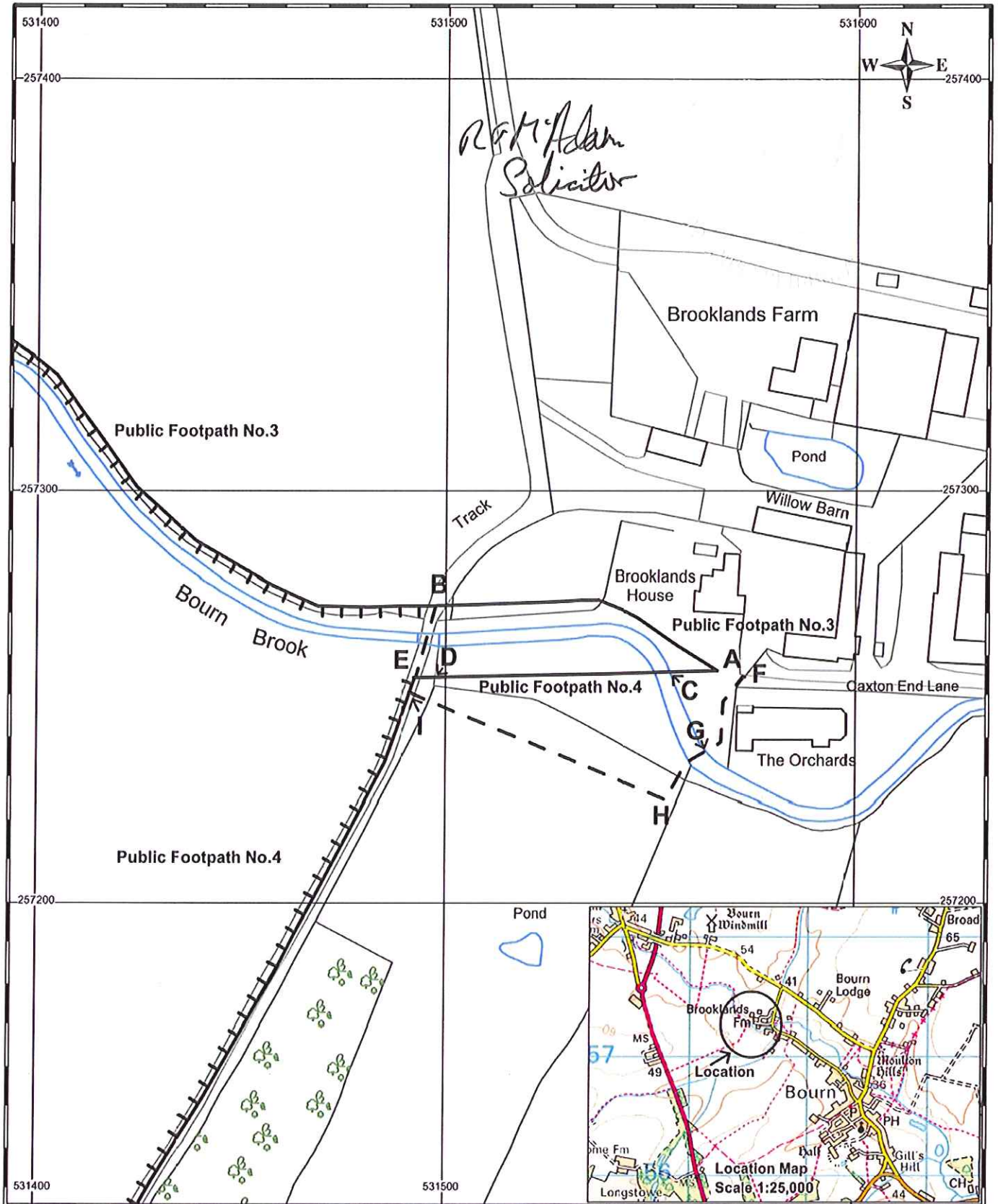
B-E on Order map	Part of Public Footpath No.3, Bourn starting on a farm track at Grid Reference TL3149 5725 (point B) and proceeding in a south-south-westerly direction over a concrete culvert to Public Footpath No.4 at Grid Reference TL3149 5725 (point E).	Length approximately 18.5 m Width 2.5m.
F-G-H-I	Part of Public Footpath No.4, Bourn starting at a gap in the boundary fence at Brooklands House at the end of Caxton End Lane at Grid Reference TL3157 5725 (point F) and then proceeding in a south-westerly, southerly and south-westerly direction for approximately 22m to a bridge over Bourn Brook at Grid Reference TL3156 5723 (point G) and then proceeding south-south-westerly for approximately 11m to TL3155 5722 (point H) and then west-north-westerly over a grass meadow for approximately 68m to exit through a gap in the hedge line onto the remaining unaffected part of Public Footpath No.4, Bourn on a farm track at Grid Reference TL3149 5725 (point I)	Length approximately 106m Width 2.5m

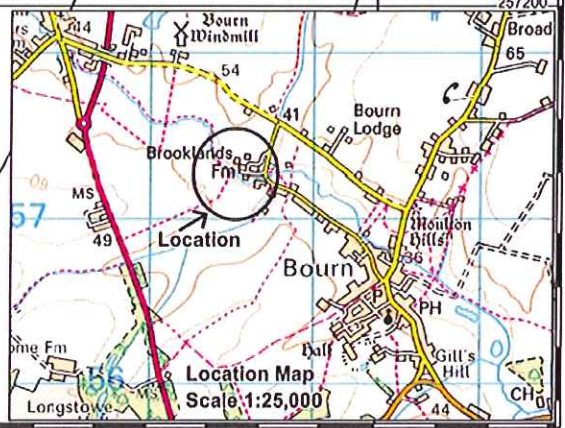
