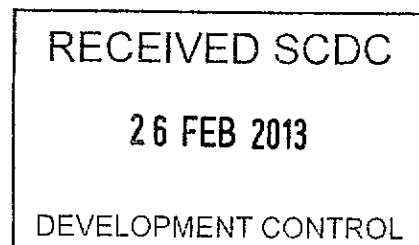

I am writing regarding planning application S/0401/13/DC for the erection of two further affordable dwellings to the existing site at Rockery Farm, Bourn (S/1151/10).

The applicant has now submitted information to discharge the conditions of the consent. Conditions 9 (affordable housing), 10 (play space) and 11 (community facilities) require the provision of a Section 106 Legal Agreement. The affordable housing will be secured in perpetuity. With regard to the open space, the applicants seek to transfer the land into the Parish Council's ownership, with future maintenance done by the Parish. They are not proposing any financial contributions towards maintenance. Could you confirm whether this is a situation that the Parish Council are happy with?? I understand there have been negotiations between the Parish and applicant on this matter.

With regard to the community facilities contribution, the applicant is not proposing to contribute financially. The contribution would ordinarily be a payment of £1,047.86. Again, has any negotiation taken place with yourselves on this matter?

If we receive a termination notice from you and you then continue to use our electricity supply after 1st May 2016, we will place you on Deemed Rates, or on an appropriate Domestic tariff if applicable, while you remain a Non Half Hourly supply customer.

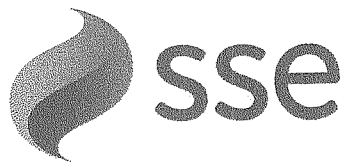
