Somerset County Council has received an application to divert the above mentioned footpaths and wishes to consult with all interested parties regarding this proposal. Please find attached a plan showing the existing and proposed routes, and their location.

The proposed diversion will move the existing paths out of yard and buildings of Brinscombe Lane End Farm and on to routes which will afford better views and walking conditions. This will mean improved biosecurity for the farm and health and safety for path users.

### Description of part of footpath AX 26/24 to be diverted

The footpath starts from the entrance to Brinscombe Lane End Farm (point A on the plan) and runs in a generally south south easterly direction for approximately 190 metres to point B

### Description of alternative route of footpath AX 26/24

The footpath will start from the southern end of the adopted section of Breach Lane (point C on the plan) and will run in a generally south westerly direction for approximately 3 metres to footpath AX 26/50 and then in a generally southerly direction through a pedestrian gate for approximately 15 metres to point X and then in a generally easterly direction for approximately 100 metres to point B. The width will be 2 metres.

### Description of part of footpath AX 26/48 to be diverted

The footpath starts from its junction with footpath AX 26/50 on Breach Lane and runs in a generally north westerly direction for approximately 270 metres to point D.

### Description of alternative route of footpath AX 26/48

The footpath will start from a pedestrian gate on Breach Lane at point E and will run in a generally north westerly direction for approximately 30 metres to point Z and then in a generally northerly direction for approximately 140 metres to point Y and then in a generally north north easterly direction for approximately 90 metres to point D.
