All exhibits must have been grown, sewn, created or painted by the named exhibitor's own efforts. Flower arranging materials are exempt from this rule.

NON-PERISHABLE EXHIBITS SET UP: Friday 14th 1.30 – 8p.m. Fresh produce set up 8.30 – 9.30a.m on show day. Show areas close at 9.45 a.m. and re-open after judging.
