- 1. Hurworth Show Committee reserves the right to make corrections and additions to the Terms and Conditions as and when necessary. Please check www.hurworthcountryfair.co.uk for updates.
- 2. Disabled badge holders and their drivers may park in the school's staff car park. Onsite parking is limited to wheelchair users and walking frame users only.
- 3. No exhibitor car parking is allowed at the Grange or on site on show day.
- 4. Car parking arrangements will be signposted and are as follows: across the road behind Hurworth Maths and Computing College and on site.
- 5. Photographs, paintings, handicrafts and flower arrangements should be brought to the Fletcher Hall or set up between 1.30p.m. and 8 p.m. on Friday 14th September. Exhibitors can also set up between 8.30 a.m. and 9.30 a.m. on Saturday 15th September.
- 6. At 9.45 a.m. the Show Hall will be closed to exhibitors and the public for the duration of Judging.
- 7. The Show Hall will re-open when Judging is complete.
- 8. All exhibits must remain on show until after the presentations and collected after 4 p.m.
- 9. Perishable exhibits left after 5.30 p.m. will be disposed of.
- 10. Other exhibits will be held for 24 hours at the owner's risk and afterwards disposed of at the Committee's discretion.
- 11. With the exception of flower arranging classes 36 to 39, all exhibits **MUST** have been grown, sewn, painted, created, or made, by the named exhibitor's own efforts and **limited to TWO ENTRIES PER CLASS.**
- 12. The exhibitor's name must not be visible on any exhibit.
- 13. An exhibit previously placed first, in any show or fair, may not be entered at Hurworth.
- 14. Failure to abide by these Terms and Conditions will result in confiscation of trophies and cash prizes and exclusion from future Hurworth Craft and Produce Shows.
- 15. The Judges' decision is final.
- 16. Trophies, shields and cups are awarded for one year only and must be returned to the Grange Community Centre office before entry closing day the following year. These remain the property of Hurworth Community Association at all times.
- 17. The Committee reserves the right to reject any entry and return fees without explanation: they reserve the power to cancel any class with fewer than three entrants.
- 18. The Committee do not accept responsibility for any loss or damage to produce or personal property during the time they are on show: all entries are received subject to this condition.
- 19. Show entry forms and fees can be registered at the following times:
 - Monday 10th September 2 p.m. to 4 p.m. and 6 p.m. to 8 p.m.
 - Tuesday 11th September 2 p.m. to 4 p.m. and 6 p.m. to 8 p.m.
 - Wednesday 12th September 2 p.m. to 4 p.m. and 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. **NO LATE ENTRIES ACCEPTED**.
