## Local Crime Reports

The list below provides a summary of recent local crimes, organised by Parish from 1<sup>st</sup> Feb to 29<sup>th</sup> Feb 2016. It is not possible to list all the crimes due to confidentiality issues (e.g. if the crime was violent or for domestic disputes). No mention then no reported crime!

### DINTON-

Between 10am and 1pm on 10<sup>th</sup> Feb a car was broken into whilst parked at the Drove area. Cash within was taken and damage caused to the door.

Between 12midday and 12.50pm on 11<sup>th</sup> Feb another car was broken into whilst parked at the NT car park on St Mary's Rd. The rear window was smashed but nothing stolen – owner states there was nothing of value in it either.

### CHILHAMPTON-

Overnight 22<sup>nd</sup> Feb – 23<sup>rd</sup> Feb offenders broke into a container which housed various industrial power tools to value of £10,000.

### SOUTH NEWTON-

Over a period between 25<sup>th</sup> Jan – 24<sup>th</sup> Feb suspects have tried to pull the black key cover off on the drivers side door, smashed off the passenger side wing mirror leaving it in the middle of the road, then snapped the arm off the drivers side wing mirror leaving it dangling by a wire, on three separate dates.
