

**MINUTES OF THE ORDINARY MEETING
OF SUTTON UNDER WHITESTONECLIFFE PARISH COUNCIL HELD ON
MONDAY 9th MAY 2016 AT 7.25 PM IN SUTTON VILLAGE HALL.**

- Present: Cllr. C. Artingstoll, Cllr. B. Carney, Cllr. J. Dickinson, Cllr. A. Pollard, Cllr. G. Thomas and Cllr. C. Worley. PCSO N. Warby. County Councillor G. Dadd and District Councillor R. Baker.
- 16.027 There were no apologies for absence received.
- 16.028 PCSO N. Warby gave a comprehensive report from NY Police and introduced the new Community Messaging system. The County was recorded as the safest area in UK.
- 16.029 Declaration of interest in items on the agenda. None.
- 16.030 The minutes of the meetings held on April 11th 2016 and the TMG Minutes from 18th March 2016 and May 6th 2016 were all approved and signed.
- 16.031 Clerk's Report. See appendix attached.
- 16.032 HDC Report from District Councillor Bob Baker. The Tour de Yorkshire had been successful and Thirsk and Sutton under Whitestonecliffe had been highlights in Hambleton. Cllr. A. Pollard noted the excellent introductory work from HDC.
- 16.033 NYCC Report from County Councillor G. Dadd. A Lambert Hospital Action Group had been formed. It was hoped to have meaningful dialogue with the South Tees Trust. Further financial cuts would have to be made but the County would try to protect the elderly and vulnerable. By 2019 there would be no Revenue Support Grant and NYCC would need to create more income, probably through more development. The Fracking application at Kirby Misperton would be decided on merit and fact. Personal views would not be allowed. The Holiday complex at Hollin Barn had been allowed on appeal. Cllr. Artingstoll questioned Cllr. Dadd on the implications for the Sutton Bank issues following the PCC election and the re-election of Julia Mulligan who had previously promised £20,000 from the PCC fund and 95 Alive funding. The Council would write to the PCC and request a confirmation of the pledges and arrange to meet again and confirm progress. It was hoped a meeting would be held with Area 2 to review signage. County Councillors were given £5,000 which could be awarded to worthy causes which may include a HGV information sign at a layby near Bagby. The Parish Council would work informally with others to design ideas for an information board. Cllr. Dickinson would liaise with Cllr. Dadd with ideas for Highways. These matters would be discussed at the next TMG meeting on 6th June. Cllr. Dadd was asked to help source a map showing village properties. Cllr. Dadd praised the village's efforts for TdY. Cllr. Pollard made mention of the invaluable support given by James Gilroy.
- 16.034 Financial Matters. Balance in Bank as 29th April 2016. £3816.27.
The Financial Committee had carried out their audit and signed accordingly. The Chairman explained that as at the meeting her budget appraisal showed £1038.78 was available.

- 16.039 Tour de Yorkshire. Cllr Pollard reported on the very successful outcome of the event with good community involvement which would be built on in the future. £605 had been raised for the Village Hall. The RNLI had played an important part in proceedings. 350 balloons were available for a good cause. The excellent photographic display would be available for future use. The Chairman thanked and praised Cllr. Pollard and also Mr Sparks for their tremendous efforts on behalf of the village.
