My name is Hannah Wheeler and I am the headteacher. I am responsible for many things within school, but also visitors, staff, students, parents, governors and contractors. I am working hard, but always welcome comments and feedback about your visit here.

If you would like to talk to me about anything you have seen, or any concerns you have, please come to my office (turn left from the front door and my room is next to Orange Class).

I am the Safeguarding Designated Person.

Thomas Snowdon is the deputy Headteacher. He is responsible for child protection and safeguarding (keeping young people safe from harm, such as illness, abuse or injury) when I am not in school. If you have any concerns or issues, he is the next in line to find. Ask in the school office if you need to see him. His office is just near the front entrance or he may be in class (Year 2). Emma Spaul is also a designate professional for safeguarding. She is the teacher in Year 2, or may be working in the Deputy Headteacher's office.

If you have concerns about me, then please contact our Chair of Governors, Jan Pierson. She can be contacted through the school office, by email or by letter.

I meet with all volunteers to discuss their focus and offer of support, as well as work experience students. Parents are welcome to come in and see me most of the time, but it is expected that they make an appointment wherever possible.

All visitors, staff and governors are requested to wear an identity badge or sticker. Please be aware, we may ask to accompany you if we have not seen formal identification or have acknowledgement that you are CRB/DBS checked.
