(VARIOUS ROADS IN THE PARISHES OF SUTTON CHENEY, SHEEPY AND
WITHERLEY, IN THE BOROUGH OF HINCKLEY AND BOSWORTH) (IMPOSITION
50MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 201

THE LEICESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL hereby gives notice that it proposes to make an Order under Sections 84, 5 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, the effect of which will be:

1. To impose a 50mph speed limit on parts of Fenn Lanes, Wharf Lane, Sutton Lane, Shenton Lane, Mill Lane, Foxcovert Lane, Stoke Road and Upton Lane in the Parishes of Sutton Cheney, Sheepy and Witherley.
