- The loss of, or damage to, goods or articles of any description brought into the building;
- Loss of, or damage to, any articles, goods or property in the custody of DADCA (or their representatives), which will be left entirely at the owner's risk.

Complaints

Any stall holder having any complaint or observation to make in respect of any matter relative to the management of the event must submit details in writing to the Secretary within 7 days thereafter.

Your Responsibilities

- If you are selling any second-hand electrical goods you should be aware that the goods must meet legal safety requirements
- If you sell unsafe goods and the goods cause injury or damage you may have to pay compensation
- If you are a Trader, Trading Standards require that you clearly display your contact details and fill in and return a booking form which is available at www.dadca.org.uk
