- 2] DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST There were none
- 3] MINUTES FROM PREVIOUS MEETING HELD ON MAY 14 2014 were accepted as circulated and signed by the chairman
- 4] CLERK'S REPORT FROM PREVIOUS MEETING
Notts County Council highways had offered a site meeting on July 17 at the junction of Browns Lane and the A606. The chairman and Coun. John Cottee had attended . The chairman said he had been in touch with the County since the meeting and was following up the discussion but would remind them of their promise to produce a report of the meeting.

Rushcliffe Borough Council Mayor Coun. Hetherington advised that the annual Mayor's Reception for Parish clerks and chairmen would no longer take place in its usual form and would be amalgamated with an event in aid of the Mayor's Charity fund.

- 8] DEFIBRILLATOR UNIT

The meeting agreed there was still a need to update the council's website. Members had looked at the one for Wysall and were impressed with it.
- 11] AGENDA ITEMS FOR NEXT MEETING NOVEMBER 12, 2014 were to include the next issue of the Newsletter and the Bench proposed for adjacent to the garage site on the A606 road.

The number of advertising signs on Browns Lane and Melton Road were raised with concerns being expressed.
