- 1] APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE Coun. Teri Browett
- 2] DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST There were none
- 3] MINUTES FROM PREVIOUS MEETING HELD ON JULY 13, 2016 were accepted as presented and signed by the chairman
- 4] CLERK'S REPORT FROM PREVIOUS MEETING

16/01231/ful. Brett Hands, 64a Stanton Lane. Two storey rear extension, pitched roofs to front dormer windows. Do not object.

Rushcliffe Borough Council planning decisions
