The crime figures for December 2015 are once again relatively low.

Some good work around stop search by colleagues at Keyworth and Tollerton in December, where drugs and an offensive weapon were found, positive action being taken in relation to these incidents.

I am sorry to say that PCSO Alex MITCHELL, who has worked with me for some time has moved onto another area as a PCSO. I would like to thank Alex for his hard work whilst he was with us.

This now leaves me and Kathy LUCOCK covering the area from a NPT front. However we do very much work as a team on Rushcliffe south/north, so we regularly get assistance from other beat areas namely East Leake, West Bridgford, Cotgrave, Bingham and Radcliffe supporting us on a regular basis.

The dark nights continue for a few weeks yet, so once again I would advise keeping an eye on your security, lighting etc. and please report any suspicious activity on 101 to the force control room.

Many times we hear that people do not contact the Police as they do not want to waste our time. Please report suspicious activity and we will assess and deal with the information as appropriate within our policies. We would much rather have a call which turns out to be not suspicious than not to receive a call and then have a crime reported later.

All reports of crime should be made by using the 999 or 101 system to report the incident to the force control room. The beat team monitor all calls to the Police involving our area and we attend those incidents that we need to.
