## 2. Hurworth

Length 2.8 miles


Duration 1 hour

Start With the Millennium Garden behind you facing the road

Terrain Easy pavements and public footpaths

Note After wet weather, the public footpath sections of this route can be muddy





- a) Cross over the road (Teesway) and turn left. Take the right hand turn into New Lane and continue straight ahead. New Lane bends right, but continue straight ahead on the track, crossing a small bridge and up to a farm.
- b) Turn left onto the grass just before the farm and cross the waymarked stile on your left. Continue straight across the field to cross a second waymarked stile. Turn right and continue on field edge to cross a waymarked stile and bridge.
- c) Continue diagonally across the field to far left hand corner and cross the waymarked stile. Continue straight ahead with the pond on your left to cross a waymarked stile.
- d) Follow the path to the left of the house to cross a waymarked stile in the hedge to your right. Be very careful here as the stile exits directly onto the road. Cross the road and cross the waymarked stile just to your right.
- e) Continue diagonally left across the field following the remains of a hedge boundary. When you reach a boundary junction with a hedge to your right, cross the waymarked stile on your right. Continue diagonally across the field to the far left corner and a waymarked post.
- f) Continue straight ahead following the beck on your left and turn left to cross a waymarked bridge which leads you to a waymarked stile.
- g) Follow the path straight ahead to join a track / lane (Timmy's Lane). Turn left and follow the track to the road. Turn left and follow the road to the T-junction with the Otter and Fish on your right and the River Tees in front of you. Turn left and take the paved path all the way back to Neasham, continuing through the village back to the start.
