


Chesterton Community Association Design a Village Sign for Chesterton

Tips and Ideas

- Do you know if you live in the Chesterton area? If you are not sure, look on the back of this leaflet for a list of street/roads that are within the East or West Chesterton boundaries.
- Use your imagination, look around you – what do you see? How do you feel about where you live? What do you like about living in Chesterton? Use any landmarks you think should be shown on the sign.
- Do you know any of the history of Chesterton? What was there before your street was built? How long has Chesterton been around? Who and what did people do in the past?
- Where do you think would be the best place for the Chesterton village sign to be erected? Think of the boundaries, where would the sign be seen by a large number of residents and visitors to Cambridge. What of many spaces around Chesterton would show the sign to its best and enhance the area?

There will be small prizes for the best entries from each local school and a prize for the best community entry. The judges' decision will be final. The pick of the entries will be displayed at Chesterton Festival.
