Treasurer's Report: Suzanne reported a balance of £696.46.

Matters Arising – The secretary pointed out that the Draft Scheme for CC's currently under consultation might have implications for the date of the AGM, which is to be held before the end of June and for the preparation and submission of Annual Accounts.

Dave Thompson, MSP, had expressed a wish to visit CC's in the Highlands and the secretary forwarded the dates of our meetings some time ago, but nothing further had been heard.

Likewise, the secretary followed up the Road Safety Meeting with emails to Scott Macmillan of Transerv and Bob Mitchell of Transport Scotland, but received no reply.

Dornie in Bloom: The group is still awaiting a decision on the application to HC's discretionary budget.

Budget Consultation: We had a brief discussion of HC's online Budget blog which gave members of the community a chance to comment on various proposals. The next Ward Forum, which is to be held on Monday, 21st June at 6.30 pm in Lochcarron Hall will be a consultation on the budget and it is expected that the Council Convenor and Chief Executive will be present.

Community Ground – Some members of the community had questioned whether the ground in front of Donan House was community ground, but a member of the CC said that the ground had been leased from Transport Scotland. He thought that it would still be possible to plant the ground with bulbs in co-operation with the leaseholder.
