

How to make a representation to the Highland wide Local Development Plan

By Post:

You can write us a letter, clearly setting out which section(s) of the plan you are commenting on. You must include your name, organisation (if applicable) and address in your letter and send it to:

By Email:

You can send us a fax, clearly setting out which section(s) of the plan you are commenting on. You must include your name, organisation (if applicable) and address in your fax and send it to:
