John VK4UC ... Thanks to the folks at BARTG for a very enjoyable contest. 10M was the best ever.

Mel W3MEL ... Thoroughly enjoyed the contest. I am new to RTTY and had a very good time. Thank you.

Miro S58T ... More contacts, more multipliers, solid band conditions, high activity – what more could organizer and testers wish?

Nick RA9MY ... I had real fun. Thanks for the very nice weekend!

Glenn AE0Q ... Solar conditions were really good, but didn't have big JA and EU runs like last year (were they all on 10m?) Highlight was being called by JD1BKR and C31PM for new countries.

Jan SM5FUG ... Excellent condx, especially on Saturday. After every BARTG I ask myself did I choose the right off-periods? This is the challenging tactical question in this contest. Don't change the 3-hour rule, someday I will learn how to handle it and I won't tell anyone how.

Jacobo P43P ... Started just as a non-serious effort, but had so much fun, I decided to go for it a little longer than planned. Nice contest and will definitely be part of it next year but with a little better plan for operating hours. (just a casual non-serious 1200+ contacts – not bad, Jacobo!)

Contest manager's comments:

We were blessed with probably the best ever conditions for any RTTY contest. All the HF bands were open world-wide for large periods of the test, and were especially good through Saturday. Intercontinental contacts were possible on 10 and 15 right through the night from the UK. This did keep things quiet on 40 and 80, and several stations commented on the difficulty in finding enough multipliers on the LF bands. A sample check of 10 entries showed some 1400 callsigns active in the contest, and the true figure will have been considerably higher. Once again there were some huge scores, including the record-breaking 4 million achieved by Don Hill AA5AU and Ron Stailey K5DJ. They set themselves a 2 million target, and just kept raising it to take advantage of the combination of excellent condx and big world-wide BARTG participation. Our top single operator was Nick UT2IZ (UW8I) whose 2.1 million was just enough to beat Jacobo P43P. Nick last won, in 1996, with a score of 600K, which would have got him a solid 36th place this year! My personal admiration is for our first-time RTTY contestant, and winner on 10 metres, Ernest PJ9/ON4CFD. OK, he's a good contestant in the right place, but the contacts still have to be made. I made about 40 in my first RTTY test, and took a week to get over the strain! A total of 93 stations entered the contest for the first time this year which is very encouraging. Congratulations to all our winners and many thanks to all who took part.

Next year we will have an extra class for experts and some minor changes in the rules for non-experts. Look out for the new rules shortly; they will be on the BARTG web site, and an announcement will be made in Datacom (the BARTG newsletter) and on the reflector.
