Contest Manager's Comments:

Conditions continue to be difficult and scores were generally down on last year. Entries were slightly down but there are still new RTTY ops trying the contests. The 6 hour class also attracted more entries this year. It does encourage those who may be put off entering a full contest, comments are favourable and several entrants in this class will have a go for a longer time next year or in their next contest. The winner, 9A7R, not only kept up a good rate but demonstrated how important it is to find the multipliers too.

Elsewhere we had no entries on 28MHz and 21MHz was dominated by South American stations. The lower bands showed increased activity and scores were up in many cases ... e.g. GM3SEK whose points were up by 15% to win on 40, while the winning score on 80 from OK1MWD was more than twice the 2006 score.

Logs were generally good but a few of the top stations were well over the 30 hours operating time. These were reduced to the first 30 hours with no further penalty and the remainder of the log used as a check log. In future contests they will be subject to greater penalties or disqualification.
