

# BARTG RTTY SPRINT 2014

**TIME/DATE:** 12:00 GMT Saturday 25<sup>th</sup> January 2014 to 12:00 GMT Sunday 26<sup>th</sup> January 2014

**CLASSES:** **SOE** Single Operator Expert **SOAB** Single Operator All Band  
**MO** Multi-operator **SWL** Short Wave Listener

SOAB entrants may only change band once in any 5 minute period. Any operator with a top ten SOE or SOAB placing in any BARTG contest during the years 2010 / 2011 / 2012 / 2013 must enter as an expert in SOE, other stations may choose to enter the expert class if they wish. The class entered must be shown in the log.

SOE/SOAB Entrants may only have one signal on the air at any time.

**BANDS:** 80, 40, 20, 15, 10 Metres amateur bands, please adhere to the RTTY mode segments of the amateur bands

**EXCHANGE:** 3 or 4 figure serial number only. **(No RST, this is a sprint contest)**

e.g. 001 or 0001..... or 199 or 1022.....

**QSO POINTS:** Each completed QSO scores one point. Stations may be contacted again on other bands.

**MULTIPLIERS:** All DXCC countries and JA, W, VE and VK areas count as multipliers. Multipliers and continents count only once in the contest regardless of band. *US stations must use correct call or suffix for their area of operation as this is used as a multiplier (if you don't like it, simple, don't enter).*

**SCORING:** QSO points x Multipliers x Continents (max 6).

**LOG SUBMISSION:** Logs must be submitted in Cabrillo format by e-mail to:

The contest name in your log must read **BARTG-SPRINT**.

**Logs must not include any 599 signal reports.**

Any incomplete or wrongly formatted log entries will be classified as check logs.

**E-MAIL:** The **subject** line of your e-mail entry must include your callsign and class entered (and that's all).

e.g. Subject **GM4KLN SOAB** Subject **GW4SKA SOE** Subject **G1XKZ MO**

Logs should be sent as a plain ASCII text attachment (No zip or adi files please!) and include callsign and full name as this name will automatically be used on any certificate that could be awarded and a valid email address, otherwise certificates will not be issued unless application is made direct to the Awards Manager. **Do not name your log BARTG.log or BARTG-RTTY.log or BARTG-SPRINT.log etc**

Please name them only with your callsign. e.g. GW4SKA.cbr GM4KLN.log G8APB.dat

G1XKZ.txt **NOTE:** All entries failing to comply with these rules will be automatically returned to sender for amendment. **DEADLINE:** All logs must be received by 00:00 1st March 2014 in order to qualify.

The judge's decision will be final and no correspondence can be entered into in respect of incorrect or late entries. All logs submitted shall remain the property of BARTG.

**Trophies** will be awarded to category winners. **Certificates** will be available for download and local printing from our website. Paper copies only by request to the BARTG Awards Manager and are charged at cost.

**ADDITIONAL NOTES:** Contestants may claim any of BARTG's extensive range of Awards from contacts made in our contests. Holders of existing awards may add new countries to their records.
